

School Health Screenings

Throughout the school year, Arlington Community Schools provides state-required vision, hearing, height/weight, and blood pressure screenings for students in specific grades as listed below. The purpose of the program is to give you information about your student's growth patterns and as an early indicator of future health concerns. We encourage you to share these results with your student's health care provider. State law requires parents to provide the school district with a signed consent or refusal in writing and/or electronic form.

School Health Screenings conducted per grade level:

- Height & Weight (PK, K, 2nd, 4th, 6th, 8th & 9th)
- Blood Pressure (PK, K, 2nd, 4th, 6th, 8th, & 9th)
- Hearing (PK, K, 2nd, 4th, 6th, & 8th)
- Vision (PK, K, 2nd, 4th, 6th & 8th)
- Color blindness (2nd grade only)

Parents are required to respond with permission or refusal for a student to receive health screenings through during registration through the ACS registration portal.
