INDUCTION PROCESS

FAQ



When can I be inducted?

- The spring of your junior year or fall of senior year

What are the requirements?

- Students must have a 96.000, or higher, cumulative numerical average (no rounding) to be considered for NHS. Your cumulative numerical average includes all grades earned for high school credit, even those taken in middle school and/or courses retaken for higher credit.

How can I prepare for NHS?

- In addition to the academic requirements, students must also have a variety of leadership and service experiences and be of good character. Service and leadership from freshman year to the induction period will be considered. It is essential to lead and serve in a diverse array of activities, including in-school and out-of-school organizations or events. Character will be based on teacher feedback and the student's high school discipline record.

STEPS

Spring of Junior Year

- Juniors with a 96.000, or higher, cumulative numerical average (no rounding) will be notified of qualification via school email.
- Students will be given instructions on how to complete the Candidate Information Form with specific due dates.
- NO LATE FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- The Faculty Council will review NHS Candidate Information Forms and score students based on the four pillars of The National Honor Society- academics, service, leadership, and character.
- Students will receive notification of the Faculty Council's decision. Students that are not accepted will be notified of the reason for non-selection and will have the opportunity to be considered again in the fall of their senior year.

Fall of Senior Year

- Students that did not meet the 96.000 cumulative numerical average or were not accepted in the spring of their junior year will have the opportunity to be considered for NHS one last time in the early fall of their senior year.
- This process will be the same as listed above.
- No students will be admitted after this session due to the requirements necessary to satisfy membership.

Membership

Once inducted, students will be required to maintain all aspects of the NHS pillars, complete 15 hours of NHS specific service, and pay a \$40 fee to cover membership and graduation related supplies.
